



Incident Date 18 Nov 2018

Incident description

Crew was conducting IP survey. Field assistant was performing the task of installing the transmitter electrodes. FA confirmed he was standing clear 2 times as per procedure (double confirmation). Electricity was applied to the electrode. Current/signal was too low to record accurate data. Receiver operator called for power to be turned off and asked for an additional electrode to be installed minimum of 5 meters from the original.

FA commenced installation of new electrode 6 meters away. The RO has asked for the power to be turned on to the primary electrode while FA was installing secondary electrode. FA confirmed he was standing clear 2 times as per procedure (double confirmation) and power was subsequently turned on. RO requested to be informed "when the electrode had been completed."

FA has attempted connection of the new electrode to the live wire and received a shock.

The FA informed all over radio that he had received a minor shock. All work ceased for incident reporting and investigation. FA taken to Hospital for examination. Medical staff cleared FA of any major injury. Fit to continue work as normal.
